LEFT TRENDS SEEN IN VENEZUELA

Chavez Venezuela — (NC) — Participating in the first general secret election that this country has known, more than 1,000,000 Venezuelans men and women went to the polls recently under the watchful eyes of the Army and gave leadership in the Constituent Assembly to the Acción Democrática party of the present government.

The elections are expected to shape the social, economic and political life of Venezuela for years to come, with important repercussions in the nation's religious life, since the Constituent Assembly is charged with the duty of framing a new national constitution.

The Communist party, despite elaborate propaganda, finished fourth with only 50,000 votes and two places in the assembly.

During its twelve months in power since the revolution in October, 1958, Acción Democrática has given considerable reason to suspect a Marxist color in its ideology though it had presented a liberal aspect when it was in opposition.
