FRENCH ENVOY WILL RETURN TO MONASTERY

Paris — (UPI) — Admiral Thierry d'Argonne, Carmelite priest and at present high commissioner for France in Indo-China, will shortly return to his monastery at Avenches, France, it has been announced.

The monk whose name in religion is Father Louis de la Trinite, has received the decoration of the Order of the Bath from King George of England. Occupying the post of Provincial of the Paris Province before the war, Father Louis de la Trinite was mobilized in 1939. He served as a naval officer, took part in several naval engagements, and became admiral in the Free French Fleet which served under General de Gaulle in 1940.
