Third Order Of St. Francis

The Third Order of St. Francis will hold a meeting Sunday, Dec. 22, at 9:30 p. m. in Rochester's St. Patrick's Church to celebrate the feast of Christmas. The custom of the Christmas crib first observed by St. Francis is one of the special feasts of Franciscans. The saint is also remembered for his untiring efforts to bring peace to the troubled world of his own time.

The Rev. Raymond Oostdyke, O.F.M. Conv., says of the Third Order: "No one is better qualified for the task of peacemaker than the good Tertiary. Following the example of Christ, it was Francis' life and teaching to bring peace to laboring classes and to stricken nations. On his death bed he declared: 'The Lord revealed to me this salutation that we should say: "The Lord give thee peace." And those words opened every sermon he ever gave. The Pope has pointed out that the Third Order has always been a powerful factor in the general restoration of peace, in the re-adjustment of society.

One of the conditions for membership in the Third Order is that the candidate have the Beatitudinal quality of being peace-loving. The Rule admonishes Tertiaries, to heal discord wherever they can. His reward shall be peace of heart on earth and the peace of the children of God in Heaven.
