Newman Club Growth Enlists 85 Priests Says Fr. Cleary

Cornell — The Rev. Donald M. Cleary, Catholic chaplain at Cornell University and former U. S. Army chaplain, guest speaker to the Holy Name Society of St. Patrick's Parish Sunday night, explained the origin and purpose of the Newman Club to the group.

Starting with a group of eight at the University of Pennsylvania, who wished to honor Cardinal Newman, Father Cleary said, the Newman Club has flourished until today there are 85 priests engaged in non-secular colleges all over the country in bringing religious instruction and services to the

Father Cleary, a member of the Rev. Thomas Cleary, pastor of St. Patrick's Church, served as chaplain for the 39th Fighter Group of the Ninth Air Force in the European Theater of Operations, landing in Normandy in the early stages of the invasion to lead the liberation of the Normandy beachhead in four years in the German fortified area of Normandy.
