Holding down second place are "Dohr Tallos" with 21 games won and 15 lost. Following closely are "Biggs Insurance" five with 19 and 27.

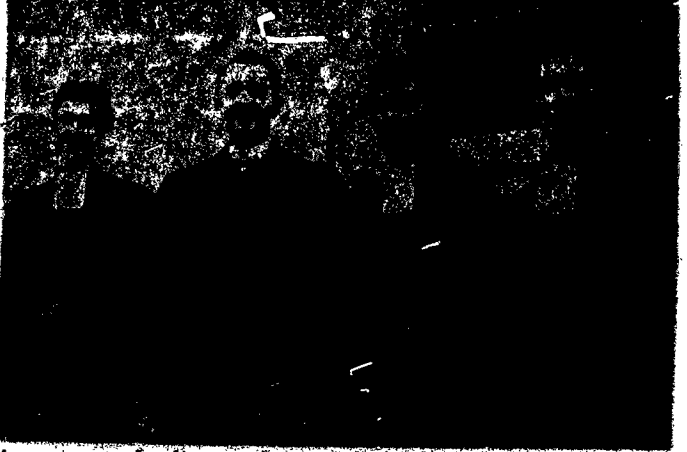

Fort Smith (Mackenzie, Can.) — A stirring rescue took place near the Mission of Christ the King, the most northerly mission station of the Vicariate of Mackenzie when an aeroplane crossing the waters here was forced down in a rough sea. There were two occupants in the plane and they scarcely had time to send out an S.O.S. before their plane disappeared.

They were just in time and were picked up by the mission boat "Notre Dame de Lourdes."

The mission boat approached and picked up the aviators in spite of the dangers from the stormy sea. One of the aviators remarked that he owed his safety to Our Lady in these words: "I owe my rescue to Our Lady of Notre Dame. I have up to now hesitated to become a Catholic. Now my mind is made up, I wish to be a Catholic."

His remarks were translated for the benefit of the Eskimoes who were present. (Helen)
