And apart from the question of peace, there must be an easier way of regulating the equitable use of the earth's resources than that of sending the little peoples of the world out on the battlefield to bleed and die for oil and coal. The centrel of the earth's goods should not depend upon the fate of armed conflict anymore than upon the chance cast of loaded dire

Lastly but more important than anything else is the necessity of reconstructing our new world according to the standards of Christian morality and justice. No decreat and liveshie world can tolerate persecution of religion and violation of man's inalienatsie liberties. But to their everlasting shame the UN peacemakers are tolerating these things. Today among the United Nations are governments which persecute the Church and deny freedom to their own citizens. This explains, as much as anything, why 1947 finds us sitting in gloom and peering, almost hopelessly, for the first faint rays of the dawn of peace.

These are the hard problems of peace and the peacemakers must solve them and solve them soon or face, as Pope Plus XII has warned, a final condemnation as "Authors of the World's Ruin.

What chiefly angers Washing ton, however, and is assumed to distress even the State Department, are the constant attacks on the United States, both in Poland's controlled press and by high official sources. Despite our racognition of the Provisional Government and our grant of credits to it in the sum of \$80, 000,000, no day passes without some ugly fulmination against America. For example, here is the preamble of a circular recently given wide circulation, and stamped with the Govern-

ment's approval. The capitalist world is preparing a third World War. This time it is to be a war against the Soviet Union, the only state of workers, peasants and working intelligentsia. Prompted by purely imperialistic motives, and a desire to gain raw materials and to dominate the world, they are pre-paring a war that will again devour millions of human beings. 
