Severe Winter Heaps New Misery on Hungry Europe

New York — (CNC) — Warning that all private relief agencies must step up their programs in war-torn Europe, Thomas J. Fox, War Relief Services-National Catholic Welfare Conference, said the organization within the last nine months. The shipments he said, included 1,000,000 cans of baby food; 375,000 cans of vegetables; 500,000 cans of milk; 300,000 cans of soup; 300,000 pounds of flour; 100,000 cans of meat and fish; 20,000 pounds of powdered milk and 20,000 pounds of coffee and coco.

The organization is not only responsible for the operation of 120 kitchens in Budapest at which 13,000 children are fed daily. Mr. Fox detailed, but it has been the accelerating factor in U.S. Military Supply Zone feeding program. In the American Zone in Austria, W.R.S.-N.C.W.C. contributed more than 300 tons of food to the project, which looks after 33,000 school children each day, when it was inaugurated and will support the program to its termination. Mr. Fox said.

The organization is not only responsible for the operation of 120 kitchens in Budapest at which 13,000 children are fed daily. Mr. Fox detailed, but it has been the accelerating factor in U.S. Military Supply Zone feeding program. In the American Zone in Austria, W.R.S.-N.C.W.C. contributed more than 300 tons of food to the project, which looks after 33,000 school children each day, when it was inaugurated and will support the program to its termination. Mr. Fox said.

For the benefit of older children, feeding program, was started last April by the Army and War Relief Services-N.C.W.C. aided with a donation of 80,000 pounds of food. The relief organization also is the greatest contributor to the Army program at Salzburg, which provides a substantial meal for 5,000 children daily.

With the aid of War Relief Services-N.C.W.C., the Caritas organization has taken the lead in helping Austrian youth. Here in Vienna, 400 students of the University and the various technical and art schools as college level

are fed high with W.R.S.-N.C.W.C. carrots, in striking contrast to the dwindling piles of potatoes and the increasingly meager supply of coal. He left no doubt about the gratitude which the students as well as thousands of other Africans feel deeply for the generosity of their fellow-Catholics in the United States.
