Monday, February 3 — St. Blane, Melop and martyr, devoted the earlier years of his life to the study of philosophy and afterwards became a physciars. He became Bishop of Sebeste in Armonia and was imprisoned by Agricolus, the governor. On his way to prison, a distracted mother whose child was suffering from a discase of the throat implaced his aid. At his intercession the child was curred and since that time his aid has been shooked in cases of throat trouble. After cruel tertures the Saint was beheaded in 316.

She returned to Bourges, where she realized her desire to establish the Order of the Amnunciation.

Wednesday, February 5 -S' Agatha, virgin and martyr. was born in Sicily of noble parents and consecrated from infancy to God. In the midst of dangers and temptations she served Christ in purity of body and soul, and dled for the love of chastity when the Governor, Quintanus, found that he could not prevail upon her to sin either through threats of tortures or offers of safety.

Thursday, February 4 - St. Dorothy, virgin and martyr. was famous at Cassares her native city, for great virtue. Her parents are thought to suffered martyrdom under Diocletian and size herself was called before the Governot Sapricius and ordered to ablure the Faith. She refused and suffered a martyr's death.
