Posing the question whether communism is opposed to west ern civilization, Monsigner Sheen stated that the term western civilization has two widely divergent meanings. It may mean Christian civilization, he said. with its emphasis on human rights as the inslienable gift of God, is affirmation of liberty as a derivative of the spirit, and its sacramental use of creation aided by redemptive grace to attain the giarious liberty of the children Another Definition

On the other hand, he declared, it may mean "our materialistic, hourgeois, cagitalistic, humanisic, liberal civilization, which alfirms that man is only a highly evolved animal, that evil is due to ignorance and can be cured by education, that the primary purpose of man is either to acquire wealth or enjoy pleasure."

While communism is diametrically opposed to the former interpretation of western civilization.
