## AOH Membership Campaign to Open Feb. 13

Directed by the Rev. Michael F. O'Brien, County Chaplain, an initiation campaign for the Ancient Order of Hibernians will be launched at a meeting Thursday evening, Feb. 13, at 8 p.m., Hotel Schenck.

Father O'Brien, former Army chaplain and now assistant pastor of St. Thomas Church is sending out an invitation to Catholic men and women of Irish birth or descent, to attend the meeting.

An organization with a "glorious past" and one that has achieved greatly for Holy Mother the Church, the Ancient Order of Hibernians will begin its membership effort with the approbation of His Excellency, Bishop Kearney.

In his invitation letter, Father O'Brien states in part:

"A little more than a year ago, a false ideology which threatened to destroy the fundamental principles of our American way of life was overcome. In the pages that will tell the story of this struggle among the foremost and oft repeated names will be those of Catholic men and women of Irish descent."

"It has always been so in the history of our Country, for Irish Catholics have played a prominent part in the formation of our Government and in upholding the principles we cherish."

The Ancient Order of Hibernians, Father O'Brien recalls was founded in Ireland centuries ago to protect the priest of the Penal Days while saying Mass. The Order was transplanted in this country to protect the Irish immigrant of the last century in its adopted land.

"To this day she has kept alive these principles and the now asks you to join with her in this purpose," the invitation states.
