Diocesan Lay Retreat League Picks Wolfe Boy Scout Units in 26 Parishes, Coleman Reports

Frank E. Wolfe of Blessed Sacrament parish was elected president of the Rochester Diocesan Catholic Laymen's Retreat League for a period of two years at business sessions held Feb. 27.

Tentative dates for retreats for the various parishes were also selected at the meeting.

Final dates will be determined at the next meeting Monday, Mar. 24, and will be printed in an official diocesan circular.

His Excellency, Bishop James E. Kearney is honorary president for the 1947-1948 retreat season.

Designated director will be the Very Rev. Augustine J. Aswad, C.S.S.R.; Rev. Edward J. Bowes, C.S.S.R., rector of the Our Lady of the Lake Retreat House, Geneva, and the Rev. Thomas J. Sanderson, C.S.S.R., confessor.

B. Edward Schlesinger, parishes of St. Ambrose Church, was elected treasurer and secretary will be George F. Schmidt of St. Augustine's.

President Wolfe is successor to James E. Cuff, who held the office from 1941 through 1944 and B. Edward Schlesinger, 1945-46 president. A report on the progress of the retreat movement in 1946 and the prospects for 1947 was given by Father Aswad. Retreats at Geneva have shown steady growth since its founder, the Rev. John P. Murphy, C.S.S.R., established the beautiful home on Seneca Lake said the rector. This point is illustrated by quoting the following figures: 1942, 130 retreatants; 1943, 330 retreatants; 1944, 496 retreatants; 1945, 570 retreatants; 1946, 760 retreatants.

Over 1000 retreatants are anticipated in 1947, he estimated. New features to be added to the retreat program will be an informal question box period for the problems of the men, and the distribution of membership cards. A statue of Our Lady will adorn the grounds when plans are completed.
