

Communists Quit Cabinet in Belgium

Amoyers (AP) — The new Belgian government has announced today that the Communists have quit the cabinet. The Communists, who had been in the cabinet since the formation of the new government, had demanded the resignation of the Prime Minister, Paul-Henri Spaak, and the resignation of the other members of the cabinet.

Mr. Spaak's new cabinet is made up of eight Catholics of the Flemish and Walloon groups, and seven socialists.

Religious interests appear safe with this new government. Antireligion seems to have quieted down. However, it is feared that the new government will be handicapped by strikes for the Communists resigned in order to be free for agitation.

TO REBUILD WAR-BOMBED ABBEY



The half-ruined Monastery in Prager, destroyed by the Allied bombardment of February 14, 1945, which will be rebuilt by Czech Catholics. Chapels and Relics Spared In Montecassino Bombing

Vallem City (AP) — An altar of the chapel housing the most three-fourths of the war-bombing debris has been removed from the Basilica of the Montecassino Abbey and it has been found that a number of chapels and altars amazingly escaped destruction. Observers from the Vatican City have reported that the chapels of St. Gregory and St. Carolomano were destroyed completely, the report indicates that the chapel of the Sacrament, built on the same site as the other two chapels, received only minor damage.

The tabernacle of the chapel of the Sacrament, a work of Casavari and similar to the tabernacle in the Church of St. Andrew at the Quirinal in Rome, has been found intact. The top of the altar, decorated with silver and bronze oak leaves, as well as the small bronze statues representing Eucharistic symbols, have also been found undamaged.

The report states that the relics of the two Benedictine saints, St. Genaro and St. Guisulone, have been found in excellent state of preservation, and that a cross, which had fallen on the

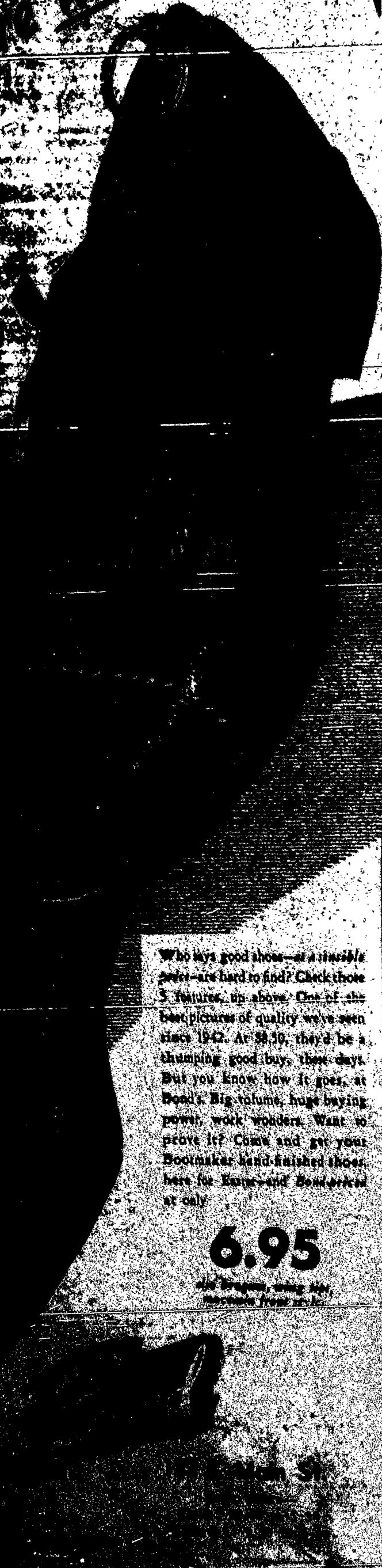

UNESCO Meet Omits Religion

Philadelphia (AP) — Virtually ignored on the agenda of the first national conference of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization, which convened here with 1500 delegates in attendance, was the subject of religion, which millions are agreed must play a prominent role in achieving a true brotherhood of man.

"Nearly everybody was here but God," said an attendee of the U. S. State Department, as she shrugged her shoulders and grabbed personal effects preparatory to making a hurried exit in the direction of Washington, D.C. She had been asked at press headquarters about possible religious highlights in UNESCO's initial assembly on New World Soil.

She was right. There just wasn't any religion in the deliberations of the hundreds of notables, many of them prominent names in the various complications of "Who's Who," assembled for three consecutive days to avert the fate of turbulent world.
