'The Juggler' Returns to N.D.

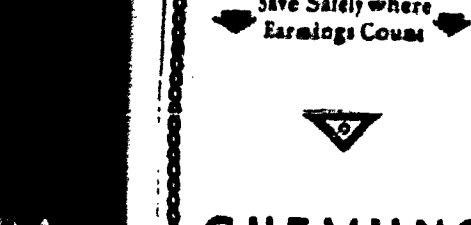

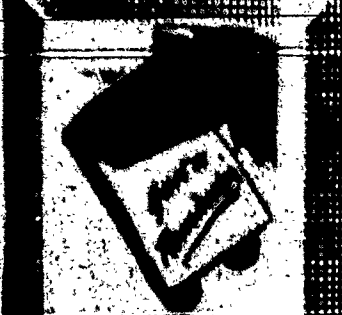
