CANADIAN BAN ON REDS ASKED


Ottawa — (INC) — Wilfrid Lacroix, a member of the Canadian Parliament has introduced into the House of Commons a bill to amend the Dominion's Criminal Code dealing with illegal organizations so as to include the Communist and Labor Progressive parties.

(The Labor Progressive Party was formed during the war after the Co-operative Party had been banned under a war measures act. The LP is generally recognized as being the Communist Party in Canada today. The LP had but one Member of Parliament in the House of Commons, Fred Rose, a Communist who is now serving six years in the penitentiary for being an agent of the Russian spy ring in Canada which was revealed in the Canadian spy inquiry last year.) Explaining his bill, Mr. Lacroix said: "The Communists party of Canada and the Labor Progressive party of Canada and organizations with similar objectives and advocating the use of similar means of overthrowing constituted authority as developed in Canada under our constitution are a menace to the safety of the state and should be outlawed by an adequate provision of the Criminal Code."

Prague Gets Crosby Film

Prague — (INC) — "Going My Way," the Academy Award-winning movie starring Bing Crosby and Barry Fitzgerald in the roles of Catholic priests, has found its way to the Czech capital city. It has opened with promise to be a long run at the Blanka, one of the city's largest theaters, and the house has been sold out for many days in advance.

Guam Addition Makes Frisco World's Biggest Archdiocese

Washington — (INC) — The Vicar Apostolic of Guam does not become a Suffragan Bishop of the Metropolitan See of San Francisco but will be listed with the San Francisco suffragans, and "will enjoy moral unity with the Archibishopric of the mainland."

Before the appointment of Bishop Apollinaris W. Baumgartner, O.F.M. Cap., as Vicar Apostolic of Guam in 1945, that jurisdiction included only the Island of Guam. Since then the far-flung Islands of Saipan, Tinian, Rota and all others of the Marianas group have been added to the Vicariate, and last of all the Ryukyu, southwest of Japan, have been entrusted to Bishop Baumgartner.

The province now includes the Metropolitan See of San Francisco, the Dioceses of Reno, Sacramento, Salt Lake and Honolulu, and the Vicariate Apostolic of Guam.

Jesuit Weather Man Decorated by U. S.

Manila, P.I. — (INC) — Before his return to Spain for retirement, the Rev. Miguel Solga, a Spanish Jesuit priest, was presented with the American Medal of Freedom by the United States Army for his aid to U. S. forces by maintaining a Philippine weather service in the early days of the war.

Father Solga was director of the Philippine Weather Bureau observatory. The Manila observatory was begun by the Spanish Jesuits under the Spanish administration and continued it on the request of the United States when this country took over the Philippines in 1898. The government, the Army, the Navy, and commercial steamship lines operating in the Far East, have commended the observatory many times for its work, particularly in forecasting typhoons.

communist, the communists of yesterday, tomorrow, and yesterday. But we know the fact that this generation, which we are responsible for, is a tremendous generation. And we have accepted the standards of our generation and even allowed certain contacts with the propaganda of yesterday.

For years we have saved our youth on a diet of gospel but concocted for the most part by Hollywood producers, book publishers, radio broadcasters and even educators.

The excesses of Hollywood and their secularistic spirit and cheap ideals, are just as much of a threat to the spiritual and human dignity of our people as were the communists of Hitler.

As one critic points out, "Hollywood teaches that love is an overwhelming impulse without rhyme or reason, which must at all cost be obeyed . . . even if it implies stealing someone else's husband or fiance."

The movie charges another observer "are being used for a progressive vulgarization of the public mind and for the debasing of public morals at a moment when the salvation of democracy depends upon the strengthening of individual moral integrity."

What these critics charge against the movies can be charged just as strenuously against our radio programs, our books, and our magazines.

At this moment when we are all worrying about the dangers of Communism, it is very timely to recognize what Capitalism has done for us. We should be able to see the truth of Chesterton's warning when he wrote that "it cannot be too often repeated, that what destroyed the Family in the chance, might have saved it."

Capitalism, if it ever had the chance, might have destroyed the American Family, but "as far as we are concerned, what has broken up households, and encouraged divorce, and treated the old domestic virtues with more and more open contempt, is the epoch and power of Capitalism."

Examine any magazine or enter any theater house and you should be convinced that in this country, at least, Capitalism has encouraged, for economic reasons, a parade of publicity and gaudy novelty, which in the nature of the beast of all that was called dignity and modesty by our mothers and fathers."

Who has been responsible in this nation for smearing at the Christian virtues of chastity and modesty? According to Chesterton, "It was not the Bolsheviks, but the Jews, the publicly man, the salesman and the commercial advertiser who have like a rust and rot of barbarism, thrown down and trampled under foot" the standards of Christian virtue and religious reverence.

American Capitalists are now looking for Communists behind every tree and especially behind every trade union. But the worried Capitalist should rec-
