PRIEST NEED SEEN IN REICH

Frankfurt (U.C.) — The continued influx of refugees and exiles from the former German provinces in the East has caused a serious shortage of clergy among Catholic communities throughout the American and British zones of occupation.

According to Bishop F. Kenny, religious affairs officer of the Office of Military Government for Greater Germany, a minimum of 40 new parishes is required for the Diocese of Limburg alone, 25 for Mainz and 40 for Fulda in order to meet the spiritual requirements of new citizens who have now settled permanently in the zone.

The result will be a profound sociological and religious change whose consequences are difficult to foresee. In many towns and villages the percentage of the refugees is higher than that of the native population. In Thuringia, for instance, there were only 4,000 Catholics before the war. The total is now 50,000. In Schleswig-Holstein, there were 5,000 Catholics before the war. Their number is now 25,000. In extreme cases, such as in the village of Sacke, Oldenburg, there are now 12,000 Catholics as against 500 at the end of the war.

indictment for contempt of Con-
gress as a result of his refusal
to testify under oath before the
House Committee.

Mission Bishop, 13 Priests Jailed by Chinese Reds
New York (U.C.) — The
Bishop and 13 other
priests of the mission of the
Austrian Jesuits in Kinghsan,
China, have been imprisoned by
Chinese communists, according
to reports received by Jesuit Mis-
sions here.
The private St. Joseph's
Brethren, S.J., of Kinghsan,
which is located in the southern
part of the Hopei province. He
was ordained in 1925 at Wood-
stock, Md., and was consecrated
in China in 1940. He is being
held along with the Very Rev.
Francis Burkhart, S.J., Superior,
and the Rev. John G. Kronthal,
S.J., Procurator of the Mission.
The report stated, it added that
13 priests of the mission are held
in concentration in a single room
in Nanjing.
The mission serves 15,000 Ca-
tholics and the general mission
priests complement numbers 23
priests and two Brothers. The
mission, according to reports, is
now without a priest. The mis-
sion officials and priests, the re-
ports related, were imprisoned
after the communists had as-
sessed a fine of \$40,000 Chinese
dollars (approximately \$7,000)
