cust by the Christian Democratic Union and the Center Party combined, which in this zone beth cater principally to Catholic volers, while the Socialists and Communists obtained 3.500,000 How. ever, the ballots cast by the Democratic and Farmers' parties, top-alling nearly 1,000,000, may be added to the Christian Democratic and Center total, since both these groups are certainly not sympathetic to socialism or com-

Red Vote Down

The Communists obtained only 879.199 votes, which is less than their total at the time of the pre-Hitler Welmar Republic even though conditions today are even more favorable to radical agita-

Of the three provinces making up the British Zone of Occupation, the Christian Democrats are by far in the lead in North Rhine and Westphalia, where they will hold 91 out of a total of 214 Diet seats there. Together with the Center Party they will send 199 deputies to the three new regional parliaments as against 173 Socialists, 38 Communists and 50 nembers of the Democratic and Farmers' Portles.

In appraising these figures, it must be borne in mind that the Socialist Party represents the prevailing moderate trend among laborers Considering the severe plight of the population of the British Zone during the past win ter unemployment, foud short age and transport difficulties, this esuit is remarkable indeed
