





Milwaukee - (NC) - May 13. of this year marks the 30th anniversary of the first apparition of the Blessed Virgin to three peasant children at Fatima, Portugal, followed by a succession of appearances which startled the world.

These events were retold officially in book form by the Rev. G. Da Fonseca, S. J., a Portuguese Jesuit, soon after the apparitions. Channing C. Barthas, French editor, brought the material up to date several years ago adapting the original volume written by Father Fonseca. This authoritative book now has been translated into English and has been published on the occasion of the anniversary under the title "Our Lady of Light" by the Bruce Publishing Company here. It is the April selection of the Catholic Literary Foundation.

In 1935, the Golden Rule Foundation decided to select a woman whose superlative qualities would be representative of all motherhood. Mrs. William Berry of Greenburg, N. C., a Catholic, was the recipient of this honor in 1941.

The mother of 13 children, Mr. Berry had four sons in the armed forces at that time. Two of her daughters are nuns and one, the Rev. William Nathaniel Berry, Jr., was ordained the same month his mother received the Foundation's gold medal.




