NUNS HAILED AS TEACHERS

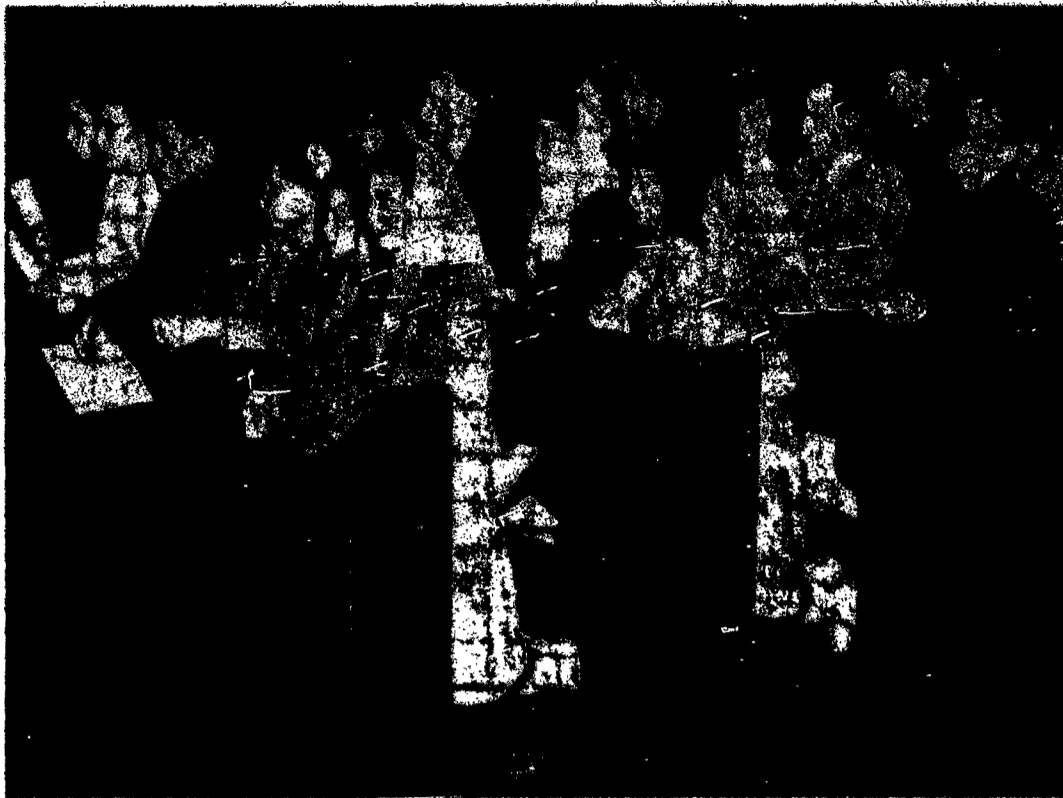
Washington—(NC)—A tribute to nuns who "worked around the clock" when they were employed as teachers in New Mexico was paid by Representative Georgia Lee Lusk of New Mexico, a former state superintendent of schools, in speaking for federal aid to schools, particularly in poorer districts that need U. S. help.

"We used Sisters as teachers in outlying districts and even more accessible districts where we could not get lay teachers," Mrs. Lusk said. "We found the results extremely satisfactory. The nuns were well-trained as teachers and fitted into the community life."

"These missionary Sisters were on duty 24 hours a day. Where the lay teacher was in school from 9 to 4, the Sisters took a keener interest in the welfare of their pupils and maintained high averages by doing far more for their pupils than actually required."

Mrs. Lusk was emphatic on one point in the federal aid program. She said that the limitation of the health aid program to public schools was inadvisable because, if the parochial schools were neglected, it would leave large numbers of children unprotected.

Plus XI put his finger on one of the chief horrors of the Communist system, when he said that "no natural right is accorded human personality." When the Red machine advances into any area, it brings a slavery which strips man of his liberty, robs human personality of all dignity. Those who serve the Communist machine are made mere puppets, too, thinking and acting only as the dictators in the Kremlin want them to think and act.

Freed Intellectuals

This is something that should be noted down and remembered vividly. Marxism-Leninism, the alleged science on which Communism is based, claims to have freed the intellect of man by ridding it of all spiritual underbrush. By that fact, it contends, man can almost mathematically foretell his future, including the establishment of the Earthly Paradise, Socialism and Communism.

In reality, by the very fact that it has robbed man of spiritual values, Marxism-Leninism has brought about the destruction of all moral standards and with that loss, the wiping out of all intellectual integrity. The sole measurement of "morality" or "intellect" is the subservience of the Communist and the fellow-traveler to the will of the Soviet dictator.

94 Earthquakes In Single Day Experienced by Bishop

New York—(NC)—Earthquakes are everyday occurrences in the lives of missionaries in that chain of islands known as the Lesser Antilles, according to Bishop Antoine Demets, Coadjutor of Roseau, British West Indies. And, to add, his diocese, which takes in five islands of the group, seems to be the earthquake center of the vicinity.

"In Montserrat," he explained, "I have experienced as many as 91 severe earth tremors—92 horizontal and two vertical—in a single day."

"Only steel and concrete can withstand such quakes," he said. "Both materials are too expensive for us to use extensively for mission buildings. The primitive roads of the islands become so rutted by upheavals that even motorcycle travel is impossible. As a consequence, a comparatively nearby sick call in the mountains may require 10 hours of travel on horseback."

It was a Redemptorist missionary that Bishop Demets first went to the British West Indies in 1924. He spent seven years working among the Portuguese, Arabs and Caribs living in the islands. In 1931 he went to Canada where he helped form a unit of the Allied Army. He was assigned a chaplaincy with the paratroopers and was raised to the rank of Chaplain General.

Notification of his elevation to the Episcopacy did not reach Bishop Demets for a month. He was traveling from camp to camp and while European papers carried the
