Last week President Truman was handed a little paper-bound volume which might become a bestselier if published with the title, "Johnny, Get Your Gun!" "Who Will Fight in World

This little book of far-reaching importance is the official report of the President's Advisory Commission on Universal Military Training. The Commission, which includes the noted scientist Dr. Karl Compton. and the distinguished Jesuit Father Edmund Walsh, has been studying the need ano nature of UMT for the past six months. As a result of its careful studies and investiga tion, the commission has come to "a clear, unanimous, and strong conviction" that UMT is "a wise and prudent investment in American security, 11berty and prosperity."

The President followed up the commission's report with a prompt request to Congress to enact UMT into law and the House Armed Services Committee will begin hearings on the matter next week.
