

gan to retreat before the German attack, they martyred all the priests and Catholics they could find, never mercifully shooting them but always mutilating hor ribly and beating there to death. This tragic priest also gave us

The Rus sians were now returning and the Germans retreating Stalin had already set up the puppet Patriarch Sergius. The Russians our resurgent ailies and part ners-ordered all these people to join the schlamatic church or be slaughtered. At the same time they "held a synod" with a few 'phoney" hishops and declared for the schlamatic church against Rome. This set the stage for the announcement, promptly denied by the Vatican, that the Rutherian Church, numbering 6,000,000 souls, had broken with the Holy

He corroborated the story of countless other DP's from the eastern countries with whom we talked when he told of Russian methods of labor-recruiting At midnight they surrounded a village and ordered everyone out of their beds into the streets in front of their homes; having seg regated all the fine, healthy specimens, they grouped them to-gether, loaded them into trucks and vans, and away they went to mines, factories, plants in the hinteriands, often as much as 230 miles from rail or road and in accessible except by plane. These poor conscripts were flown innever out . they worked until they dropped; their story became usually a low short, intense chapters of suffering, poor food, end-less hours of labor, sickness.
