### U. S. Churchmen to Study Army Problems in Europe

Washington — Embarking on a 30-day mission which will include a study for the War Department of problems facing the U. S. Army in Germany and Austria, a party of leading U. S. clergymen will leave this country on June 24. It has been announced by Secretary of War Robert P. Patterson.

The group will include representatives of the Catholic, Protestant and Jewish faiths, the announcement stated, and will make two day stops at Rome and Geneva. The tour will include stops at Vienna, Berlin, Munich, Berchtesgaden, Heidelberg, Frankfurt on the Main, the Hamm Cemetery in Luxembourg, and will end at Frankfurt, where the group will hold conferences with military and civilian officials of the occupation forces. The group will make its report to the Secretary of War upon return to Washington, July 28.

The itinerary of War Secretary and the group are "a continuation of the spiritual leadership of the church" and said it was charged with the grave responsibility of presenting the religious problems of international affairs. He said that the task which "still lies ahead in Europe is one which really concerns the American people and I feel that as a Christian we believe our religious leaders have a definite responsibility to familiarize themselves with all problems involved in developing a program of international relations which will insure a peaceful Europe."

The Catholic members of the group will include: George Flynn, Msgr. James H. Gleeson, Chancellor of the Military Ordinariate and pastor of Christ the King Church, Cincinnati;

Trip of Reich Priest Blocked by British

Cologne — (Radio, NC) — The Rev. Hermann Joseph Schmidt, chairman of the Catholic Workers Union of Western Germany and one of the foremost leaders of German Catholicism, who had been invited to visit Holland to discuss common problems of the Catholic Workers' Unions, has been refused an exit permit by the British occupation authorities even though his Dutch visa already had been granted.

Father Schmidt spent one and a half years in Nazi concentration camps, and the refusal of the British authorities to grant him travel facilities is causing widespread unfavorable comment here.

The 72-year-old Prester will seek his 50th anniversary in seven languages: English, Italian, French, German, Spanish, Portuguese and Latin. This will require him to go before the cameras and battery of eight 18 different times, as each version of his appeal will be shot twice.
