**Two Schools Share Honors In First CWV Track Meet**

Top honors in the first annual track and field meet sponsored for parochial schools by Monroe County Chapter, Catholic War Veterans were shared by contestants from Our Lady of Mt. Carmel and Our Lady of Perpetual Help schools.

**Fatima Requests Can Halt Atheism, Fr. Shamon Avers**

Auburn — That small band of atheists enclaving Russia and half of Europe will be destroyed if the requests of Our Lady of Fatima are fulfilled.

This was the theme of an address by the Rev. Albert J. Shamon of Rochester at the annual banquet of the Catholic Action League of St. Alphonsus Church held Thursday at Springdale Inn. The dinner was attended by 80 members and guests.

A native of Auburn, Father Shamon is a member of the faculty of Aquinas Institute, Rochester and an assistant priest at Old St. Mary's Church of that city.

Characterizing the story of Fatima as "simple as is God" and "beautiful as is the Mother of God," the priest related the recorded facts of the vision in which Our Lady appeared 30 years ago to three little children at Fatima, Portugal.

The apparition was seen six times, on the thirteenth of each month from May to October. Father Shamon recounted, and Mary caused a miracle to be performed to confirm the authenticity of her message.

"To symbolize her power over the split atom, the Mother of God had her son perform the spectacular miracle of the sun, witnessed by 75,000," he stated.

He reiterated the familiar requests of the Fatima vision, namely, offering of sacrifices in order to atone for sins and those required for avoidance of sin for the conversion of sinners, recitation of the Rosary with meditation on the mysteries, reception of Holy Communion on five consecutive first Saturdays of the month, and wearing of the brown scapular as a sign of consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

"Two alternatives, therefore, face the world," Father Shamon concluded. Reject Our Lady's requests, and the world, as in the time of the deluge, will be destroyed, as in the time of Elijah, that small band of atheists enclaving Russia and half of Europe will be destroyed. So Our Lady has promised.

Father Shamon's mother, Mrs. Aada Shamon of Auburn, and Rev. Edward Shamon, his brother of Rochester, were among the guests at the banquet. Rev. Clarence Gardner also attended.

Mrs. Mary Snyder was toastmistress. Following vocal selections by William Bates and Nancy Bates, brother and sister team greetings were extended by Mrs. Louise Verma, president. Rev. John Widman also gave a brief address.

Mrs. Meehan was songleader and Kenneth Mahaney played piano. The committee in charge included: Mary Pincney, chairman, Florence Crowe, Olive Garbinsky, Mary Grancy, Elsie McDonald, Agnes Richard, Marion Fasse, Jeanne Giannino, Catherine McCarthy, Louise Verma, Mary Shaw and Mary Snyder.
