There is no defense for the white supremacy policy which denies the demands of social privileged Negroes into dirty gheltoes. How can Negroes be clean and decent when we never give them the chance.

How can a Christian and democratic society explain the barriers facing Negroes who seek employment? It is an elemental demand of Christian social justice that all workers (black or white) be given a chance to earn a wage sufficient to provide for the needs of themselves and their families. For most Negroes, however, the Job prospect is restricted to the meanest of nursuits and therefore the meanest of incomes.

Negroes will never under stand the reputed benefits of democracy as long as a democratic society restricts his crav ings for dignity and advancement to the grim service of the garbage wagon, or the shoe shine stand, or the role of a punch-drunk prize-fighter absorbing punishment for the en-sole defenders of the common tertainment of white folks ailting at the ringside.
