

Catherine's Secret Her confessor, a Pather Aladel. knew Catherine's secret and he publicized the details of the de votion that the Blessed Mother had ordered. The medal was called "miraculous" because of the method by which it was made known in a heavenly vision and because of the extraordinary favors that have come to those who have worn the medal and

practiced the devotion to The Blessed Mother. While the miraculous medal came to be known throughout the world. Sixter Catherine re mained unknown for she was convinced that revealing her identity would not increase devetten to Mary but would only satisfy curiosity and attract un welcome attention to herself. St. Catherine died Dec. 31

1878 and was declared Blessed by Pope Plus XI on May 21. 1933, after thorough study of the virtues of her life and the verification of two miracles that had been accomplished through her intercession. Body Incorrupt

On the day that she was beatlfied, her grave was opened and the body was found dry and intact after 56 years in the cut fin. The hands which had rested in Our Lady's lap were extraordinarily supple and the eyes were a vivid blue as when the Sister was alive.

Her holy body rests today under the same alter in the Motherhouse chapel where she had seen the apparations of the Blessed . other.

of Blessed Catherine had been




