Poles Protest School Bill

Wawow - (RNS) - Bishop Szymon Chomanski of Warsaw has protested to Premier Joseph Cyrankiewicz against a bill now being prepared by the Polish Ministry of Education which the bishop charged would liquidate Roman Catholic schools.

According to terms of the measure, only state schools will be sanctioned after next autumn when the bill is expected to be enacted into law. Forty Catholic high schools, including a number of minor seminaries, and the Catholic University at Lublin, will be affected.

It is felt here that the bill is likely to affect adversely the Vatican's decision to send an Apostolic Visitor to Poland, a step which might have led to the general improvement of relations between Poland and the Holy See.

Tallahassee, Fla. - (RNS) - Attorney General J. Tom Watson of Florida has ruled that the state Constitution does not exempt church-owned property from taxation unless it is used exclusively for religious purposes.

partly so common to our capitalistic economy between family needs and family income?

There is no easy solution to this old problem. We must reject immediately, of course, the proposal of the Planned Parenthood League. This barbaric remedy not only offends the Christian conscience but leads ultimately to the complete destruction of all family life.

Charity, according to Plus XI, is an indispensable step for those who would lighten parenthood's burdens. The practice of Christian charity on the part of friends, neighbors and those who enjoy prosperity

can be a real source of encouragement to struggling parents.

Justice, too, is an indispensable step. This is something to be kept in mind by employers and those who have the responsibility to establish wages, prices and profits. And if all these efforts of private resources prove inadequate then parents must look to the government for relief. This is something that the championships of private enterprise should remember.

As Pope Pius states, "It is the duty of the public authority to supply for the insufficient forces of individual effort, particularly in a matter which is of such importance to the commonweal, touching as it does the maintenance of the family and married people. If families, particularly those in which there are many children, have not suitable dwellings; if the husband cannot find employment and means of livelihood; if their necessities of life cannot be purchased except at exorbitant prices; if even the mother of the family to the great hurt of the home, is compelled to go forth and seek a living by her own labor; if she, too, in the ordinary or even extraordinary labors of childbirth, is deprived of proper food, medicine, and the assistance of a skilled physician, it is patent I call to what anemic married people may lose heart, and how home life and the observance of God's commandments are rendered difficult for them."

If our experts in American Capitalism have any ideas on how to cut the Stork's lavish expense account they should step forth. Otherwise Uncle Sam must come to the rescue. The right to raise a family must not become the exclusive luxury of the wealthy.
