### French Employers In Social Reforms

Paris — (RNS) — Increasing numbers of French Catholic employers are reported to be participating in an effort to bring about social reforms advocated by Pope Pius XI in his encyclical "Quadragesimo Anno" and by the 1945 Assembly of French Cardinals and Archbishops.

### French Employers In Social Reforms

Owners of factories and work shops in various parts of the country are introducing these reforms in order to create "a community spirit which will really be an extension of Christian brotherhood into business." The reforms include formation of a workers' grievance committee, payment of bonuses, salaries proportionate to the yearly turnover of the factory, and the development of employee services such as factory canteens, free medical attention, and the installation of recreational equipment for use by workers. Some of the reforms now in operation were described by delegates to a recent congress of Catholic employers. A manufacturer of aluminum household goods who employs 1,000 workers has introduced a system of production bonuses. Bonuses up to 16 per cent of individual wages are distributed and the work climate in that factory has changed completely, with a resultant increase in production. Another employer not only introduced a bonus system but permitted employees to use company tools and equipment every Saturday to make items for their own use or to sell on their own in a firm of 200 people specializing in electrical installations for all sorts of profits after taxes are shared between owners and workers. Half the workers' share is given to technical experts and the balance to unskilled laborers. The experts' share is being reinvested in the business, a scheme which gives them part ownership of the company.

### Catholic Workers Appeal For Hospitality House Aid

"To feed the hungry, to clothe the naked..." Zealously engaged in the corporal works of mercy for the last ten years, members of the Joseph's House of Hospitality this week are issuing an appeal for money, food and clothing to continue their charities.

The Rev. George C. Vogt, chaplain of the Hospitality House, points out that each year during the last several years more than 20,000 men have been given 300,000 free meals at the South Avenue institution—between 50 and 100 men daily. "Food is expensive, and we have a big family," the appeal states. "The price on old newspapers and magazines which we have been collecting has gone down, which is one of the reasons we are holding out our hand." Overall cost of conducting the house, Father Vogt said, is about \$65 per week. No one connected with the work is paid, it was stressed, with everything that is received being turned into food, clothing or lodging. Donations of food, clothing and newspapers may be sent to the house, 402 South Ave., but all financial contributions should be sent to the Rev. George C. Vogt, 2021 East Henrietta Road, Henrietta, New York, according to the appeal.

Kenny, curate at Swords, a village near the airport. He was assisted by his brother, Father J. Kenny of San Francisco, and Father Fergus Lawless, O.F.M., Cap., of Oregon. Other units of the Irish air fleet will bear the names of Saints Colmille, Kiernan, Malachy, Aidan, Albert, Declan, Finan, Colman, Ronan, Senan, Celsus, Mel Flannan, Jarlath and Felin.
