Catholic Workers Appeal For Hospitality House Aid

"To feed the hungry, to clothe the naked . . ." Zcalously engaged in the corporal works of mercy for the last ten years, members of the Catholic Worker Group at St.

Joseph's House of Hospitality this week are issuing an appeal for money, food and clothing to continue their charities.

The Rev. George C. Vogt, chap lain of the Hospitality House, points out that each year during the last several years more than 20,000 men have been given 300, 000 free meals at the South Avenuo institution-between 50 and 100 men dally.

"Food is expensive, and we have a big family," the appeal states. "The price on old newspapers and magazines which we have been collecting has gone down, which is one of the reasons! we are holding out our hand."

Overall cost of conducting the house, Father Vogt said, is about \$63 per week. No one connected with the work is paid, it was stressed, with overything that is received being turned into food, clothing or lodging.


