Gratitude and an urgent appeal are in a letter from Germany received by the Ca-Catholic Kolping Society of Roch ester and signed by the Rev Fritz Wertholt of Luebeck, Diocese of Oznabrueck-North.

"We are bearing so much through the war." Father Wertholt writes. "Our parish which ten years ago had about 4,000 Catholics, has increased to 30,-000. But not by conversions. That would indeed be wonderful.

"The newly-arrived brothers and sisters, however, belong to the poorest of the poor, who in the East have lost their homes together with their belongings. Thus, the local Kolping Society faces problems which we alone carnot evercome. We simply campot heal the wounds of the many brothers and sisters, no matter how active our love. 
