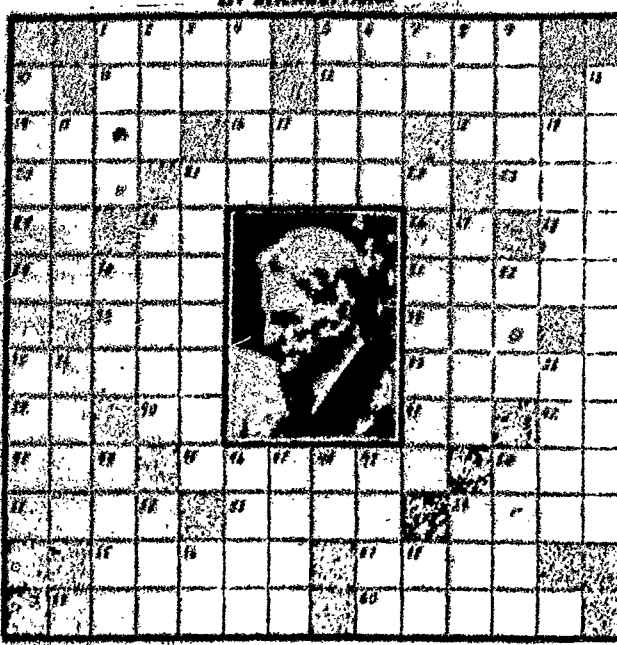

Miracles Recalled as U.S. Honors Statue of Virgin

(The author of the following story is a journalism student at the University of Notre Dame. A fighter pilot in the Army Air Corps during World War II, he recalls the celebrated miracles of the "bridge of ice" and the "opening of the eyes," and other wonders attributed to the miraculous statue of Our Lady of the Cape of the Cap de la Madeleine Shrine, near Three Rivers, Canada. Affectionately known as the "Queen of Canada," the statue is now enshrined across the U. S. on a pilgrimage to San Francisco.)

Notre Dame, Ind., (NC) — In a small Catholic Church in Cap-de-la-Madeleine, near Three Rivers, Quebec, Canada, scores of crutches adorn the north wall near the world-famous Shrine of Our Lady of the Cape. These crutches are the testimony of the hundreds of people who have claimed this beautiful Madonna and have been miraculously cured.

This past week, students and faculty at the University of Notre Dame and residents of many other places throughout the Midwest have been privileged to have special services honoring the presence of this statue in their churches. The statue is being brought from Montreal, to San Francisco with the Holy Pilgrimage, sponsored by the Confraternity of Pilgrims.

The story of this statue and of the many miracles attributed to the intercession of the Blessed Mother due to veneration of Our Lady of the Cape is one of the most interesting annals of the Catholic faith.

IN 1845, THE year of the proclamation of the dogma of the Immaculate Conception, a generous parishioner of the small Church at Cap-de-la-Madeleine was inspired to present to the Church a good sized statue of the Madonna — a Virgin with lowered eyes and delicate features — destined to rest on the altar of the chapel.

The statue was to become the center of the Shrine whose fame spread far beyond the boundaries of the parish.

Parents Willing Social Worker Can Help Boy Backward in School

would keep the old Church intact and dedicate it to the devotion of Mary under the title of Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary. That same day a bridge of ice appeared and workmen started building tons of cut stone across the river.

The ice on the river was so thin that in spots the men were able to poke sticks through the sheet into the water. It did not appear that the ice could support any weight whatsoever, nevertheless they worked all night and the next and no one was injured.

Perhaps the most remarkable story about the statue concerns those who have seen the Madonna open her eyes and actually gaze across the heads of the people praying at her feet.

On the 22nd of June, 1888, according to a sworn and signed affidavit by Father L. E. Dugan, a curate of the parish at that time, a sick man arrived at the Shrine. He approached the Shrine accompanied by two priests, Father Luc Deslats and Father Frederic.

AS THEY KNELT at the altar under the statue of Our Lady of the Cape, according to the testimony, the eyes of the statue opened and looked out ahead of her into the length of the Shrine, and the elevation of her gaze provided the appearance of a person looking far into the distance.

But, this is not the only sworn testimony concerning the "opening of the eyes." Pierre Lacroix, on January 14, 1893, under oath, signed a legally sealed statement that corroborated the testimony of Father Dugan.

The discovery of behavior disorders in their early stages and the first step to help the child by referral to the proper agency are the direct responsibility of the school. Catholic Charities can accept a child for service only with the consent and cooperation of the parents.
