

Religion Study Curb Grows in Red Zone

Berlin — (NC) — Fear is expressed in informed quarters that all religious instruction will soon cease in schools throughout the Soviet zone of occupation in Germany.

The latest measure tending in this direction is reported from Dresden, Saxony, where local Communist authorities have decreed that religious classes can be held on Thursdays and Sunday only and then outside of regular school hours.

The reason given for this measure is that the pupils are "too tired" to attend such classes since they cannot be included in the regular curricula. This latter provision, of course, being an entirely artificial and forced upon both teachers and pupils against their will.

IN BERLIN, the City Council has adopted a law which would leave the supervision of all public education to the municipality which, in turn, is controlled by Communists and Socialists. All religious denominations of the city have protested against this measure.

Equally indicative of the trend now prevailing in the Soviet zone is another report from Dresden stating that the great art exhibition now held in that city does not include a single religious painting. The exhibition is sponsored by the "Cultural League for the Democratic Re-education of Germany," an organization un-

der the exclusive control of Communists. It will be remembered that some of the greatest religious paintings of all ages, such
