Warning against many false and unjust notions regarding these refugees, Monsignor Carroll said they are able and anxious to work and "are only asking of humanity a chance to resume their own work, trade or profession for the purpose of reconstructing a normal family

He said it was necessary for governments to understand "that these refugees constitute a group of possible immigrants who are worthy of consideration and who may be relied upon for loyal service and faithful citizenship toward any country that may of fer them hospitality"


