Rising Bigotry In U.S. Deplored At Shrine Mass

Washington (NY)—The rising tide of religious tensions in the country today, the Rev. Edward W. Stanford, O.S.A., prior of the Augustinian College, stated at a Pontifical Mass today in the last day of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception here.

"There is at present in the United States a religious intolerance which has an unreasoning fear of the Catholic Church and who mixed into all her beneficent works a desire for national domination especially in matters of education," Father Stanford declared. "At the same time he added, 'There is nothing to be gained by making reckless statements or by making reckless accusations with vicious innuendoes. Just as reckless-speaking Americans can give occasion for unthinking and impudent Catholics, so unthinking Catholics can give occasion for reckless-speaking Americans. It is in religious intolerance especially disturbing because it threatens at a time when the United States is needed to combat the forces of atheism and when a united American citizenry is needed to cope with the very serious problems that threaten the future of our democratic way of life.'

The objective alleged against the Catholic Church in this country, 'moral censorship, control of Church and State,' the priest continued. 'Certainly, one of the communist charges levelled against the United States is imperialistic domination, capitalistic exploitation and fascist slavery.'

"It requires great patience and tact on the part of the Catholic leaders and people to deal wisely with the situation," Father Stanford stated. "Information and more information is required to correct mis-information and to lay out the truth. It is with Catholic information centers, Catholic broadcasts and in some extent the printed word contribute to this end. But here again, actions speak louder than words. Our deeds as Catholics must speak louder than our words. Catholicism as a way of life must be above challenge as actually manifested in the public and private lives of the members of the Church."

 of ridiculous, some sincere, colleagues.

The colleagues are not questioning Hope's patriotism. They are only evaluating his senses of good taste as a radio comedian. And the result is not very flattering to Mr. Hope.

Mr. McLaughlin's own indifference to good taste is betrayed in his strange tribute to his friend Hope. He writes:

"This country pays off for class and class alone. When I say 'class,' I mean one who has, well let's call it the sensitive touch—some one who knows what his fellow Americans will pay for."

THAT YOU HAVE the McLaughlin radio for class in comedy. If the public pays for it! As long as it pays off at the box-office anything goes.

In his cheap attempt to ridicule the student pollsters, McLaughlin was also grossly unfair. He was careful not to give their side of the argument.

Here are some of the reasons given by the students for rating Bob Hope's program as low in acceptability:

"Whitewash and job's outgroup... Jessel kept bringing in Forever Amber, which is unacceptable in itself... dirty jokes... too suggestive for children or anybody... generally rotten... not even suitable for adults... crude... vulgar... demoralizing to womanhood... Jessel ridiculed marriage... suggestive... Hope is a bit vulgar. Very vulgar is extremely unbecoming. Jessel makes light of marriage, and Columbia's jokes were vulgar... pretty shoddy."

THAT IS WHAT good Americans youngsters think about Mr. Hope and some of his associates. These colleagues are just as patriotic as Hope or McLaughlin. You can't brush off these young people with smart remarks. They are blessed with a sense of decency and good taste. They comprehend the respect of Americans whose tone or humor is more sensitive than Hope's outlandishness of McLaughlin's witcracks.

If Mr. Hope has a latent sense of good taste he should be worried by his current record in the students' Radio Acceptance Poll. It must hurt to discover that you have offended young people to whom decency is more important than the box-office.

Meanwhile, this column casts one big vote for the college boys and girls. Keep it up, friends! You can't lose when you vote on the side of good taste!
