Elks Hear Plea For Prayer at Memorial Rites

Prayer is the thing most needed in the world today declared Municipal Judge John F. Schleppl of New York City in the memorial address at Rochester Lodge of Elks paid tribute to 41 of their members who died during the past year.

The ceremony was held Sunday in the Clinton Ave. North clubroom of the Elks. Exalted Ruler William H. McLaughlin, presided.

Unless the world returns to religion there is no hope of recovery from the miseries of today, Judge Schleppl, past president of the New York State Elks Association admonished.

"We are prone to deal too much with material things and forget that 'man does not live by bread alone,'" he said.

"We cannot expect material peace and satisfaction until the world is spiritually at peace."

The judge is a member of St. Gabriel's parish, Queen and active in the Holy Name Society of that parish. He is a member of the Bishop Malloy Retreat Band in Brooklyn and of General Sherman Council, Knights of Columbus.

Knights of Equity Enjoy Yule Party

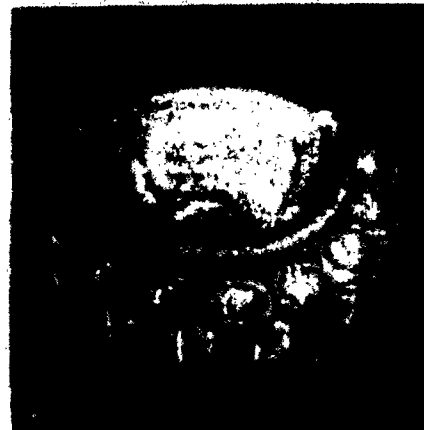
Annual Christmas party of the Knights of Equity was held Wednesday evening, Dec. 10 at Corpus Christi Hall.

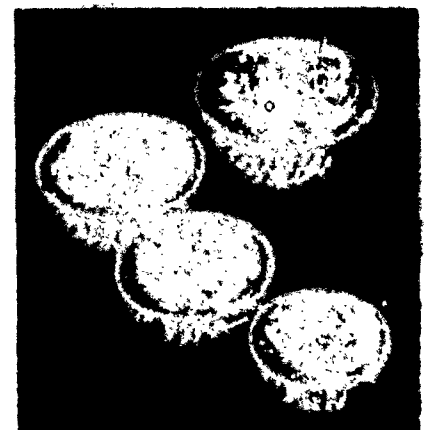

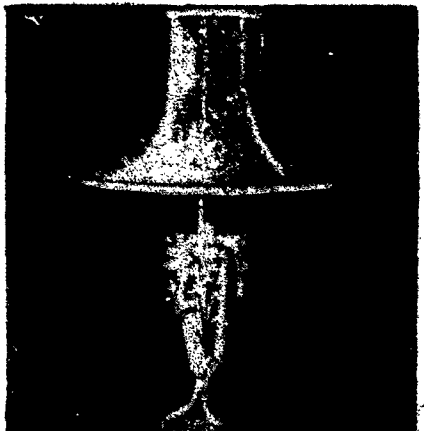
