On Monday, Dec. 23, the fraternity will be guests of Monsignor Lyons at an open house at the St. William House, Buffalo Road at 8 p. m.

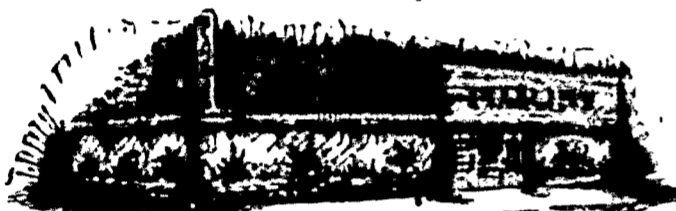

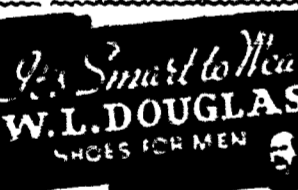
