

## Displaced Person Plea Heard by Geneva Women

Geneva — Significance of the allusion to America's "golden dove" inscribed about the Statue of Liberty was pointed out in an address by Mrs. George Hall, public relations chairman of Geneva unit, N.C.C.W., before the January meeting of the unit at Women's Building Wednesday, Jan. 21.

Calling attention to the needs of the displaced persons who she said "have survived unbelievable horrors," she quoted the Statue of Liberty inscription: "Give me your tired; your poor; your huddled masses yearning to be free; the wretched refuse of your teeming shores. Send these, the homeless, tempest-tossed to me. I lift my lamp beside the golden door."

Mrs. Hall then questioned: "Has there ever been a time when these words were more of a challenge to our justice or our charity, than today?"

**POTATO FAMINE**, pogroms, poverty, persecution, displaced our ancestors from their European homes and brought them to America. And if the Congress of that day had in utter disregard of Christianity refused entrance to these displaced persons, the names of Eisenhower, Nixon, Patton and others might be names of people who fought against us, not the names of American heroes."

Referring to the Stratton Bill, which would authorize immigration of 400,000 displaced persons to this country, Mrs. Hall said, "today we are paying annually \$70,000,000 for the support of refugee camps in Austria, Italy and Germany."

Polish, Ukrainian, Jews, Baltic, Judge-Slavs and others are in the displaced group. The third group particularly are pitiful remnants of a race on whom was visited a blood bath such as the world has never seen, and please God will never again." Mrs. Hall commented.

Mrs. Thomas Hoiger, president of Geneva unit, presided.
