They have been secured," he added. For the prevention of future wars Father Walsh pinned his hopes on the United Nations, but added that certain steps must be taken to remedy "weaknesses" which have been the origins of past wars. These dangers to permanent peace he listed as follows: (1) Excessive nationalism and insistence on unlimited sovereignty by individual states; (2) Failure to organize the old League of Nations on a sound basis because collective security at the time was only half at tempted and without sufficient preliminary psychological groundwork; (3) Inequitable access to essential raw materials, and (4) The problem of overpopulation in some countries for which reasonable outlets must be provided.

British Catholic Doctors Fight Nationalization

London — (NC) — Britain's Catholic doctors, backed by clergy, press and public, are taking a leading part in the medical profession's national revolt against a government plan to nationalize the health services, because of the moral implications involved. The plan, already approved by parliament, is known as the National Health Service Act. It comes into force on July 5 but its implementation has still to be debated in the House of Commons. Under the act, the British Government would buy out all individual practices at a cost of \$264,000,000. Doctors would then receive a basic state salary and would be directed and controlled by the state as civil servants. Catholic doctors fear that under the law an individual doctor may on occasion have to choose between carrying out a policy which he deems immoral or surrendering his only means of livelihood. He would no longer be free to refuse advice on such immoral procedures as birth control and artificial insemination; a Catholic surgeon might be asked to perform artificial sterilization, legal abortion, euthanasia. Refusal would mean dismissal or would, at least, en-

Anglican Prelate Backs Marriage End London — (NC) — Echoing the statement made some time ago by His Eminence Bernard Cardinal Griffin, Archbishop of Westminster, the Anglican Archbishop John Fisher of Canterbury affirmed that "it is the Christian duty of man and wife, unless prevented by physical causes, to have children, and either partner by seeking to prevent this against the will of the other is guilty of grave sin."
