**Booking Heavy For Lourdes Tour**

Victor C. De Prez of the De Prez Travel Bureau who are agents for the National Pilgrimage to Rome and Lourdes under the personal direction and leadership of His Excellency, Most Rev. Richard J. Cushing D.D. reports that advance reservations are very heavy.

In connection with the main pilgrimage which will leave on August 14th and will visit Paris, Lourdes, Nice, Rome, Florence and Paris, starting from Chertoung on September 9, a series of four other tours are planned. These tours will be 38 days, 46 days, 52 and 60 days duration. Some of the places visited will be, Venice, Lucerne, Brussels, Amsterdam, London, Edinburgh, Glasgow, Belfast, Dublin, Killarney and Cork.

From the advance reservations already received by the Catholic Travel Bureau it is expected that the Pilgrimage will be heavily booked long before literature is published. Anyone contemplating joining the Pilgrimage, is urged to select the tour desired and forward registration fee. Accommodations are assigned in the order of receipt of registration. Accommodations will be limited. Early requests are encouraged.

**Third Order Of St. Francis**

The Third Order of St. Francis will welcome new members into their group at a meeting on Easter Sunday afternoon at 3:30 p. m. in St. Patrick's Church, Plymouth Avenue North.

The story of Our Lady of Fatima and the publicity given to the family rosary crusade has centered new interest in the popular devotion of the rosary. Members of the Third Order have a special rosary known as the Franciscan Crown which has seven decades instead of the usual five. Franciscans may receive a plenary indulgence for each recitation of the Crown.

The Franciscan Crown dates back to 1422 when the Blessed Mother appeared to a young Franciscan novice and urged him to "weave for me a crown of your prayers." She asked him to recite one Our Father and 10 Hail Mary's in honor of her seven joys: the announcement, the visit to Elizabeth, the birth of her Son, the adoration of the Child in the Temple, the appearance of the Christ to Mary, and her assumption and coronation in Heaven.

The novice recited the prayers as the Blessed Mother directed and during the devotion an angel appeared weaving a wreath of roses with a golden lily inserted in the crown after each tenth rose. The angel placed it on the head of the novice. When the story of the heavenly apparition spread through the Franciscan Order the members promoted the practice of reciting the Crown of the Seven Joys.

year a leap year by inserting an additional day in February.

The Julian Calendar was still inaccurate, however, because the earth's journey is made in a little less than 365 1/4 days. By 1582, the error amounted to ten days.

Pope Gregory dropped these days from the calendar and ordered that a leap year should be observed in 1600, but not in 1700, 1800 or 1900, and that thereafter century years would be leap years only when they are divisible by 400. The Gregorian calendar is so nearly exact that there will be an error of one day only in 3,500 years.

The Gregorian calendar was accepted in the Western World, but the East retained the Julian method. However, with the exception of a few Catholics of the Byzantine Slavonic rite, the whole civilized world was using the Gregorian Calendar in 1924.

The 700th anniversary of the foundation of world-famed Cologne cathedral will be observed on August 16. It has been announced, and invitations to attend the solemn functions have been extended to relatives all over the world by His Eminence, Josef Cardinal Prings, Archbishop of Cologne.

The great church, which suffered considerable damage during the war, will be formally reopened on this occasion. An exhibition of church art is to be held at the same time and a symbolic drama will be presented on the square facing the cathedral.

**Canandaigua Women Hear Teen-Age Problem Talk**

Canandaigua—Parents' duty to inform their teen-age children on sex and health problems was stressed by Mrs. Bernard Florack of the National Council of Catholic Women's Speakers Bureau at a meeting of the Rosary Society in St. Mary's church hall.

Approximately 150 members were present. The society voted support to a free chest X-ray service sponsored by the Ontario County Tuberculosis and Health Association in this city April 15 through April 17.

At the April meeting it was announced, Miss Annette Floridan, executive secretary of the county TB and health association, will show a moving picture. She will explain the necessity of the chest X-rays for everyone over 15 years of age.

MRS. FLORACK, treating of teen-age problems, said in part: "Psychologists may differ on a great many things. On one point, however, they are unanimous. As the twig is bent the tree is inclined. As the child is trained from birth to the age of five he will in the main probably continue to the day of his death."

"For any questions asked," she said, "the parents should have a calm and emotional answer and a true one. Mere instruction is not a safeguard unless counteracted by a general and systematic training of the character and above all else by a thorough development of will power."

"Of what avail will be the most accurate knowledge relating to sex and health if the individual does not possess the power to act according to his knowledge in the hour of trial? Remember, knowledge is not a virtue. All the Ph.D.'s are not saints; neither is ignorance innocence."

New York (NC)—Expressing the hope that a "distinguished Catholic journalist" would be appointed to the post, Fordham University officials have announced the establishment of the Joseph Medill Patterson Chair of Journalism in the school's Department of Communication Arts.

The chair, or professorship, was made possible through the generosity of the late publisher of the New York Daily News, it was disclosed. The sum of \$50,000 realized by Fordham from Captain Patterson's estate as Osining, N. Y., left by him to the school when he died in 1946, will be applied as a partial endowment toward the chair.
