**Catholic Viewpoint Given
On World Church Council**
Amsterdam — (NC) — Catholics should neither fear nor despise nor minimize the World Council of Churches which will be established here next August by more than 125 Protestant and Orthodox communions, writes the Rev. Maurice Bevenot, S. J., in the Catholic weekly, "L'Espresso."
The Catholic Church, he adds, does not adhere to the Council, because she could not do so without denying her own nature. Founded by Christ, the Catholic Church must be, must remain and has remained a unique and visible totality, and her absence gives evidence that a world-wide unity of Christians is already in existence, the author explains.
By her absence, the Catholic Church, contributes, perhaps, more toward reaching the ultimate goal of Christian unity than do the churches affiliated in the World Council, Father Bevenot argues.
Explaining that the establishment of the World Council will be the culmination of 20 years' ecumenical efforts on the part of Lutherans, Calvinists, Anglicans and other Protestant bodies as well as Eastern Orthodox communions, he poses the question whether this step will henceforth lead to a division of the world between the Catholic Church and the "World Council" he answers, "No means no." He answers, "for the World Council does not claim to be a Church; it is a federation of churches, each one keeping its own autonomy, while, by a peripheral contact, they will try to reach some common declaration."
