### Third Order Of St. Francis Group Sends 1200 Letters to Italy

Ceremony of profession will be held by the Third Order of St. Francis Sunday, Apr. 25 at 3:30 p. m. in St. Patrick's Church, Plymouth Avenue North. Monthly meeting will take place as usual at St. Patrick's and visitors will be welcomed especially prospective members who will be interested in seeing how the novices are professed. One of the speakers at the Sixth National Congress of American Tertiaries last summer was the Most Rev. Richard J. Cushing, Archbishop of Boston. He said in part: "THE LOVE OF St. Francis for Christ took four special forms of timely significance in our day: "St. Francis had a unique love of the Crib of Jesus Christ... "St. Francis had a burning love of the Cross of Jesus Christ. To know Francis the end of all knowledge and to him the crucifix was the explanation of all the bitter mysteries of our life. The Franciscan tradition has kept this love, a love which may yet illumine the hearts and minds of a generation scandalized by the repeated triumph of evil, by the heartbreaks of displaced persons, of bombed villages, of broken homes, of scientific torture chambers and all the rest of the sorrow-spreading instruments of a civilization which imposes so many crosses because it has turned its back on the Cross... "It was through love of the altar that Francis taught fidelity to the Roman Church, veneration of his priests and perseverance in the pursuit of life eternal. "Finally, Francis taught a love of souls. The Crib, the Cross and the Altar were the three great sources at which Francis fed the burning affection of his soul, and derived strength to follow Christ in the utter abandonment and the majestic constancy of love. They spoke to him of a splendid surrender of self in an ecstasy of charity, of an emptying of Divinity that staggered his mind and filled his whole being with the heroic desire to give himself gladly, and to spend himself fully, as a loyal knight in a grand apostolate of passionate love for souls."
