### Bolster Family Unity Catholic Women Told

Washington — (NC) — Positive programs for strengthening family unity, particularly in the fields of child training, religious devotions and recreation were urged upon American Catholic women's groups by the Board of Directors of the National Council of Catholic Women.

The Board, in its statement, released here, appealed to Council affiliates to share in a special collection of 5,000,000 new children's garments for the Holy Father for relief purposes, to be conducted between May 1 and September 8. These affiliates number 5,100, with a total membership of 5,000,000.
