Hollywood The Iron Curtain By W. H. Mooring

The outbreak of picketing which attended the New York opening of "The Iron Curtain" seems like a press agent's dream come true. Hullobaloo and Ballyhoo are identical twins.

The Communists, Wallace for President and all their fellow travelers decided to warn the public to "keep a way from Fascist films," well knowing that the good sense of Mrs. America would take care of that.

What they really wanted W. H. Mooring to say was "stop Hollywood making anti-Communist films."
