Dramatic Taxation Episode Slated On K.C. Broadcast

Ithaca — A tense moment in the reign of King Edward I, of England, is dramatically recaptured in the fifth of the "Foundations of Our American Ideals" programs, which will be heard over Stations WHCU, 870 on the regular dial, and WHCU-FM, 97.3 on the FM dial, on July 20, at 7:15 p. m.

The series, which is a presentation of the Supreme Council, Knights of Columbus, and is sponsored locally by Ithaca Council, No. 277, traces through a chain of notable historic events the sources of the rights stated in the Declaration of Independence and implemented in the Constitution of the United States.

This fifth program recalls the attempt of King Edward, almost five centuries before the American Revolution, to impose taxation without representation. The result was not a 13th century "Boston Tea Party" but the general effect was the same.

Out of this incident, the "Foundations" broadcast shows, came arrangements for instructing the people in their political rights and educating them to the democratic principle that people do not exist for government, but government for the people.

Latin Rite Patriarchate Rome — (RNS) — Archbishop Giacomo Testa, recently-appointed Apostolic Delegate to Palestine, has been named by Pope Pius XII as regent of the Latin Rite Patriarchate of Jerusalem. It was announced here. The patriarchate has been vacant since the death last year of Patriarch Luigi Parlissina.
