New York - (NC) -- Moslem eaders are among the strongest HOMOGENIZED MILK opponents of Communism in Indonesia. Archbishop Georges de Jonghe d' Ardoy**e, first Apostolic** Delegate to Indonesia, declared in an interview here.

As believers in God, Moslems are opposed to any movement shich denies His existence, Archbishop d' Ardoye said. The Catholic Church is flourishing in Indonesia, he said, praising the kindness and cooperation of Dutch and Indonesian officials.

ARCHBISHOP D' ARDOYE, who was born in Belgium and is on his first visit to this country, said he came here at the invitation of His Eminence Francis Cardinal Spellman, Archbishop of New York, who was his guest last May in Batavia, Java, where he resides. He came by air via Belgium and expects to remain in this country about six weeks. During his stay here, he said, he hoped to arouse interest in founding a Catholic university in Indonesia, where there are 750, 000 Catholics. The territory covered in his delegation extends from Sumatra to New Guinea. Archbishop d' Ardoye, who speaks English fluently, was appointed first Apostolic Delegate
