Cornell Alumnus American Scientist and Business Man Leaves Lap of Luxury for Monastery

New Westminster, B. C. — (NC) — Frater Bede Reynolds, 36-year-old convert and newly professed Benedictine monk, who will begin studies for the priesthood here at Westminster Priory, was once a wealthy scientist. Three years ago before he chose to dedicate the remainder of his days to the austere Benedictine life, Frater Bede had spent all his days in the provincial lap of luxury.

WIDELY KNOWN in the fields of science and business, he was Kenyon L. Reynolds, hailed by horticulturists for hybridizing new varieties of narcissus. He was one-time vice president and general manager of the Pacific Gasoline Company in Los Angeles, and director of the natural gas and gasoline division of the Petroleum Administration in Los Angeles during World War II.

It was the devout faith of his wife, a Catholic who died in 1945, and the example of his brother, who became a Catholic priest and died in 1928, which led Kenyon Reynolds to the Catholic Faith.

He was the youngest son of Henry G. Reynolds, one-time secretary of the Michigan Agricultural College East Lansing, Mich., where he was born in 1912 and his brother were reared in a devout Episcopalian home. He was educated at Pasadena High School, Cornell University and the University of California, where he obtained a degree in civil engineering.

HIS BROTHER, Graham Reynolds, graduated from Yale University and entered the Episcopal Theological Seminary in New York to prepare for the ministry. In his final year, Graham Reynolds left the seminary, became a Catholic and then studied for the priesthood at Dunwoodie Seminary, Yonkers, N. Y. Following his ordination, Father Reynolds became a professor of classical languages at the Catholic University of America in Washington. He died in 1928.

Meanwhile, Kenyon Reynolds had married a Catholic in 1915. His wife's loyalty to her faith had made a deep impression upon him and this was increased by the dignity and beauty of the Catholic rites at his brother's funeral, emphasizing the life in the next world.

In 1932 Kenyon Reynolds decided to take instructions in the Catholic Faith, but, as he puts it, "with no notion of ever becoming a Catholic." He met twice a week with a priest and at length was received into the Church on June 30, 1933. Under the influence of his friend, Father John Handly, a Paulist, he became a daily communicant.

Mr. Reynolds and his wife were without children. When she died in 1945, he distributed his wealth among various charitable enterprises and on September 12, 1945, was admitted as a Benedictine oblate at the Westminster Priory here.

A central crusade office already has been opened here under the direction of the Rev. Patrick Peyton, C.S.C., director of The Daily Family Rosary Crusade.

The Saskatchewan Crusade, conducted jointly by the five dioceses of the Province, will be modeled on the successful crusade of the London, Ontario, diocese, directed also by Father Peyton.
