Bishops Say Czech State Directs Anti-Church Plot

(Continued from Page 1)

IN A REFERENCE to the disciplining of several priests who took public office under the new Communist regime, the letter said:

"We are being accused of being a state within a state. This impression is caused by the inevitable disciplinary measures that are necessary in case of priests running for political offices. This question, however, is only further evidence that relations between Church and State have not been settled and no effort has been made to arrange this matter."

"Since the State recognizes the Catholic Church, it must also respect its laws as incorporated in church regulations. It must respect the right of the Church to investigate the activity of members who have betrayed their duty toward the Church and punish them."

"We have explained before that this punishment is not for political activity as such or for endorsing the people's democracy but for disobedience and a breach of the priest's oath."

THE LETTER then turned to a discussion of measures taken against the Church's means of confidence on our part were not circulating information.

"Full endorsement and full possible," it said in this regard, "because from the beginning of the negotiations competent state representatives showed distrust toward the Church by banning almost all Catholic publications in Bohemia and Moravia, especially the widely-circulated weekly Roccevac."

Seminarians Move From Jerusalem Area

Rome — (NC) — With the escape of 45 seminarians from the Syrian Minor Seminary at Jerusalem after two shells had exploded in the garden without injury or damage, virtually all students have now been evacuated from the city.

The students reached Damascus via Amman and took refuge at the Major Seminary of Charfe. They chose this course rather than risk using the summer residence, Abu Gosh, at Qaryat al Anabi which is on the Jerusalem Jaffa road, over which bitter Arab Jewish fighting continues.

The Major Seminary of Charfe is now the principal refuge for teachers and students from many Catholic institutions in Palestine. The Syrian Minor Seminary is nine miles from the Holy City, on a site near where the Ark of the Covenant once rested briefly.

"Back to Land" Theory

London — (NC) — His Eminence Bernard Cardinal Griffin, Archbishop of Westminster, told Young Christian Workers at Hove, Sussex, he does not favor the "back to the land" theory as the best way to solve problems in England.
