**New School To Honor Hero-Priest of Guam**

Agaña, Guam (NC) — The staff for the Father Duenna Memorial High School and Junior College has been recruited and it is expected that the institution will be opened in late September or early October. It has been announced here. Final arrangements are awaiting the return here of Bishop Apollinaris Baumgartner, O.F.M., Cap., Vicar Apostolic of Guam.

The institution will serve as a memorial to Father Jesus Basa Duenna, Guamanian hero of World War II. Father Duenna was suspected by the occupying Japanese forces of harboring Americans and was executed on July 13, 1944.

The school was planned by the Bishop in December, 1946, and approved by the Governor of Guam. The Stigmatine Fathers will be in charge of the institution.
