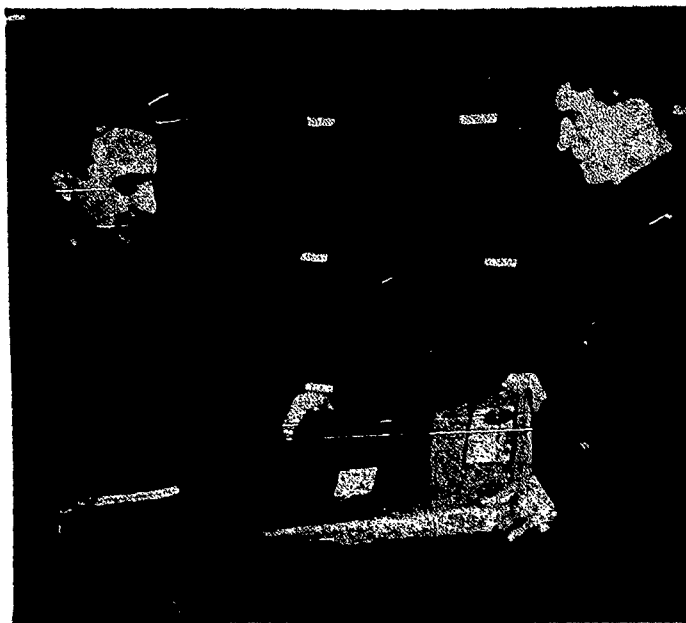

Vatican Issues Report On Work For Refugees

Rome — (RNS) — In the seven years from 1939 to 1946 the Vatican's information bureau dispatched 11,000,000 messages in reply to inquiries from persons seeking the whereabouts of refugees and prisoners of war. This figure appears in a "White and Yellow Book" published by the Vatican. One chapter of the volume recounts assistance referred to Jewish refugees.
