**Ithaca Church to Mark Golden Jubilee**

Following the precedent of the European Gothic, the Ithaca church acquired permanence by the use of stone. The exterior is of Ohio white sand stone, with red Medina or Potsdam sand stone for trim. Interior columns supporting the side walls of the nave are of red granite with white sand stone for bases.

Redecoration of the church's interior was affected by the Rev. Walter F. Lee when pastor in the middle 1920s. A flat metal ceiling was removed, the roof rafters and wood trusses were encased in cypress and the high-pitched ceiling completed.

Later, improvements to the sanctuary were instituted and carried out by the present pastor, Father Byrne. These improvements include marble altars, a new pulpit, a new sanctuary railing and a complete redecoration of the church.

In his letter, Father Byrne paid high tribute to the late Rev. Alfred J. Evans, planner of the church.
