Alleged Anti-Semitism in Spain Draws Repudiation

 issued by the Spanish Embassy in Washington.

"Nowhere in the text issued by the ecclesiastical censor, which is nothing more than a private expression of opinion, is it said that Christian charity should not be extended to Jews, as was rightly contended by His Eminence Francis Cardinal Spellman and the Rev. John LaFarge, S.J., in their individual statements," the Embassy announcement said.

"THE BASIC grounds on which the cinematographic board substantiated its decision are that this film gives rise to the controversial racial questions of anti-Semitism and anti-Semitism. This problem does not exist in Spain and in no way should be provoked.

"During World War II Spain helped and protected Jews. The Spanish diplomatic missions gave them full asylum and aided their escape through the Iberian peninsula to other lands.

"The status of the Jews in Spanish Morocco is further proof that anti-semitic prejudices are unknown in Spain.

"It should also be remembered that in November, 1944, the World Jewish Congress adopted a resolution of which this Embassy was officially notified on December 13, 1944, in which the congress expressed its gratitude to the Spanish government for the protection it offered to Jews under the then prevailing difficult

conditions in a German-dominated Europe," the Embassy statement concluded.

In Madrid, Gabriel Garcia Espina, president of the Film Board of Censors declared that the Hollywood picture was banned because its subject matter—anti-Semitism—was no problem in Spain.

The Board president also scored as "calumnious" the statement attributed by The New York Times correspondent to the Board in connection with the ban. "The Board is not a member of the Board in connection with the ban," he said.

Through love of individuals, nations and all peoples, including, naturally, the Jews, it is not possible to torment the propagation or errors such as some contained in the film, through its Spanish text as made available by Fox Films for dubbing. (Dubbing is defined as providing a film with a new sound track.)

"There is no racial problem in Spain," said Senor Garcia Espina. "We do not know here the conflict of anti-Semitism or anti-Semitism."

And precisely because of the beautiful and traditional Spanish idea of human freedom, these anguishing racial differences that have disturbed so much, and apparently do disturb, the lives of the peoples, are alien to us and we want them to continue being alien to us.

Phone Call To Rome Clears New Bishop's Consecration

London — (NC) — Five hours before **Mgr. Andrew Beck, A.A.** was due to enter the sanctuary of Westminster Cathedral to be consecrated **Coadjutor Bishop of Brentwood** it was still uncertain if the ceremony could take place. The **Bull of Appointment** had not arrived from Rome. It could not arrive; it had to be signed by the Secretary of the Sacred Consistorial Congregation and the Secretary, **Cardinal Rossi**, had died suddenly a few days before.

Another form of authorization, a faculty, was therefore necessary, but this, too, had not arrived at midnight on the eve of the ceremony.

The Rev. **Derek Worlock**, secretary of His Eminence **Bernard Cardinal Griffin**, and the Rev. **John Key**, secretary of **Bishop Edward Ellis of Nottingham** — who was to serve as co-consecrator — began telephoning the Vatican at 2 a. m. and finally managed to contact His Eminence **Giuseppe Cardinal Pizzardo**. The Cardinal, in no way put out by being awakened at about 2:30 in the morning, took up the matter at once, waking, in turn, other Vatican officials.

At 5 a. m. a telephone call giving the text of an official telegram authorizing the ceremony — and already on its way — was received at Westminster. A few hours later **43-year-old Monsignor Beck**, first Augustinian of the Assumption to become a member of the British Hierarchy, was consecrated **Titular Bishop of Tigia** and **Coadjutor to 82-year-old Bishop Arthur Doubleday**. **Archbishop Peter Amigo**, Bishop of **Southwark** — who is 83 — was co-consecrator with **Bishop Ellis**. **Cardinal Griffin** officiated.

 world by her blockade of Berlin.

In face of the Russian veto privilege, the all powerful Security Council has no power to force Russia to lift its cruel starvation blockade from the German capitol.

Under the United Nations Charter, Russia has no reason to fear that the Security Council will take any action against her. This is how it works: American, British and French statesmen make their charges against Russia. But when they have finished their formal accusations Russia's **Andrei Vishinsky** can stand up and declare a veto against any Security Council action against his country. That ends it and everybody is right back where they started.

ALTHOUGH THERE is little hope, if any, that the Security Council can do anything to resolve the "cold war" in Berlin, there is some value in the fact that the big three Western powers have taken the extreme step of accusing Russia before the Security Council.

The Western powers' accusations against Russia are important if only for the reason that the world is now hearing the truth about Russia from the all-important sounding board of the United Nations.

This is not the first time that statesmen have found truth their strongest weapon when it comes to a showdown. More and more in recent months Western statesmen confronted with Soviet aggression and obstruction, have abandoned the expediences and niceties of diplomacy to speak the blunt truth about Russia.

This sudden popularity of truth among the Western statesmen gives us some hope that even yet we may be able to stop Russia short of war. There is every reason to believe that the men of Moscow fear truth more than they do our atomic bomb.

Bible Reading Upheld in Schools of Maine

Augusta, Me. — (RNS) — Devotional exercises may be conducted in the public schools of Maine, Attorney General **Ralph W. Farris** ruled here. He notified the Boothbay Harbor school committee that "The Supreme Court ruling in the Illinois case does not apply to Bible reading and recitation of the Lord's Prayer."

Farris' assistance was sought by the Boothbay Harbor school committee after **Frank C. Hughes**, Squirrel Island atheist and retired judge, had threat-

ened court action to stop Bible in Maine schools.
