arrive; it had to be signed by the Secretary of the Sacred Consistorial Congregation and the Secretary, Cardinai Rossi, had died suddenly a few days before.

Another form of authorization, a faculty, was therefore necessary, but this, too, had not arrived at midnight on the eve of the ceremony.

The Rev. Derek Worlock, secretary of His Eminence Bernard Cardinal Griffin, and the Rev. John Key, secretary of Bishop Edward Ellis of Nottingham - who was to serve as co-consecrator-began telephoning the Vatican at 2 s. m. and finally managed to contact His Eminence Gluseppe Cardinal Pizzardo. The Cardinal, in no way put out by being awakened Card. Piszardo at about 2:30 in the morning, took up the mat-

ter at once, waking, in turn, other Vatican officials. At 5 a. m. a telephone call giving the text of an official telegram authorizing the ceremony-and already on its way-was received at Westminster A few hours later 48-year-old Monsignor Beck, first Augustinian of the Assumption to become a member of the British Hierarchy, was consecrated Titular Bishop of Tigia and Coadjutor to 82-year-old Bishop Arthur Doubleday. Archbishop Peter Amigo, Bishop of Southwark-who is 88-was coconsecrator with Bishop Eilis. Cardinal Griffin officiated.


